“For me, the table is a spatial anchor—a surface where patterns of connection, rhythm, and collaboration unfold. We come from a design tradition shaped by geometry and systems, but with Re-norm, I wanted to loosen that framework and let the form emerge from how we truly interact—fluid, collective, and always in motion. It’s not about dissolving function, but redefining it: creating a table that acts as both object and infrastructure, supporting the evolving rituals of work, dining, gathering, and shared presence.n.”



<b>About the Designer</b>	Maria Bruun’s Copenhagen-based studio moves fluidly between furniture, interior, and exhibitions — always rooted in material sensitivity and sculptural form. Trained at the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts, her work reflects a deep respect for Denmark’s design legacy, while offering a distinctly contemporary voice. Balancing artistic intention with everyday function, she sees no divide between the poetic and the practical.

<b>Description</b>	The Re-norm Table reimagines the way we meet, gather, and connect—bringing a new sense of normal to everyday moments. Its sculptural form transitions effortlessly across settings, offering both intimacy and openness. With a sail-like silhouette and sides of varying lengths, it breaks from rigid formats to invite a more fluid, inclusive experience. Made using FSC™-certified (FSC-C028824) wood, its honest materiality and quietly expressive details challenge conventional table design while remaining intuitively appealing and warm.
<b>Material</b>	The tabletop and legs are made from plywood and finished with oak veneer, walnut veneer, or painted ash veneer, all treated with a water-based lacquer. Exposed plywood edges and bullnose details are stained to match the tabletop. As oak and walnut are natural materials, slight color variations may occur. The table includes a powder-coated steel mounting bracket and adjustable plastic glides. The table is made using FSC™-certified (FSC-C028824) wood and produced without intentionally adding PFAS.
<b>Cleaning &amp; Care</b>	To clean the table, the surface should be wiped with a cloth dampened with water. If needed, a mild detergent or dish soap may be used. Concentrated or abrasive cleaning agents should be avoided, as the finish may be damaged. After cleaning, the surface should be dried thoroughly with a soft, clean cloth to remove any remaining moisture. Spills, grease, or residues should be removed immediately to reduce the risk of stains and marks. A trivet or coaster should always be used, and glasses, cups, or other items containing liquids should not be placed directly on the tabletop. Please note that the painted surface of the light blue variant is more delicate and may be more prone to visible scratches and wear compared to the veneer options.
